Planning Remote Guided Reading

- Use guided reading modified planning template, focus on independent reading level/high accuracy
- Select book, assign to students
- Plan review and locate activities on modified planning template
- Refer to Leveled Book Lesson for teaching points and discussion ideas

Planning Remote Guided Reading cont.

- Plan practice activities on modified planning template
 - Check Lesson Resources section for practice ideas during live guided reading session
 - Assign word work and writing activities for practice to be reviewed later
- Notify students to read assigned text and be ready for guided reading session

Teaching Remote Online Guided Reading

- ***Students pre-read the assigned text***
- Meet 2 to 3 students in virtual classroom using web conferencing software
- Project book on screen
- Follow review and locate sections on modified planning template
- Get ready to read – students read aloud with teacher modeling proper fluency
- Follow teaching point section on planning template

Teaching Remote Online Guided Reading cont.

- Follow practice section on planning template
 - Project practice components from Lesson Resources
 - Use whiteboard and marker, magnetic letters for word work as needed
 - Project writing prompt or question or type in chat for students to work on independently, share writing during online session, at the start of the next session, or have students post their work

Remote Online Teaching Tips

- Keep groups small with only 2 to 3 students
- Use mute all and unmute students as needed
- Use thumbs up and thumbs down for quick check ins
- Focus your time on book discussion because this is the hardest part to supplement remotely and because your students want quality time with you

Remote Running Records

- Select a text from the benchmark book collection, download text, comprehension questions, running record form as needed
- Meet with 1 student in virtual classroom using web conferencing software, record the meeting
- Project text on screen, decide whether the teacher will control page turning or if control will be given to student

Remote Running Records cont.

- Listen as student reads text aloud and take a running record on paper
- Conduct a comprehension conversation using comprehension questions as a starting point
- Thank the student, conclude the meeting, analyze the running record
